PROGRAMS

Ending the Silence

NAMI Ending the Silence is a free, evidence-based, 50-minute presentation designed for middle and high school students. Your students will learn about mental health conditions through a brief presentation, short videos, and personal testimony from a young adult who describes their journey to recovery.

NAMI Family-to-Family

For families and friends of individuals with mental illness, designed to facilitate a better understanding of mental illness, increase coping skills, and empower participants to become advocates for their family members.
