NAMI PROGRAMS

► **Ending the Silence**

NAMI Ending the Silence is a free, evidence-based, 50-minute presentation designed for middle and high school students. Your students will learn about mental health conditions through a brief presentation, short videos, and personal testimony from a young adult who describes their journey to recovery.

► **NAMI Family & Friends**

A five-hour seminar, offered quarterly, to provide basic information and support for those with loved ones who have a mental health condition. Pre-registration is required: (509) 452-8229

► **NAMI Family-to-Family**

For families and friends of individuals with mental illness, designed to facilitate a better understanding of mental illness, increase coping skills, and empower participants to become advocates for their family members. Designed as an evidence-based program by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA).

► **NAMI Homefront**

An education program specifically for loved ones of military service members and veterans who experience symptoms of a mental health condition. Classes meet weekly for six sessions.

► **NAMI Provider**

NAMI Provider is a staff development program for healthcare providers, administrative staff, operational staff, and students working directly with people affected by mental illness. It's an experience that equips participants with a deeper understanding of mental illness and the confidence to serve individuals and families collaboratively.
